2 PREREQUISITES TO BE ABLE TO STUDY IN THE PROGRAMME

For bachelor programmes: a secondary school-leaving certificate. If a foreign qualification is recognized on the basis of a Flemish degree, a Belgian law, a European Directive or an international convention, the holder will get direct access. Admission may also be granted to students after individual assessment of their secondary education certificate and to persons who are unable to meet the general admission requirements.

3 CONTENT OF THE STUDIES AND THE DEGREE

The study of Bachelor in speech and language therapy is a 3 year professional bachelor program (180 ECTS) that leads to a Professional Bachelor degree in Speech and Language Therapy.

In the first year the emphasis is on normal development, assessment and additional professional skills. The courses in the second year are focused on therapy, clinical placement and additional professional and research skills. In the third year the emphasis is on complex cases, interdisciplinary approaches and intensive clinical placement.

4 OTHER INFORMATION

Higher education in Flanders is organized at universities and university colleges. They are grouped in associations. From 2004-2005 they have operated within a uniform European framework of studies, offering bachelor's and master's degrees.
