

Presentation of the University of Castilla-La Mancha, Spain

UCLM is a regional public University. Currently there are over 27.000 students, in Faculties and Centres in 4 Campus of 4 different cities, where 70 Degrees can be studied. UCLM has been recognized with Golden Level of the Excellence (EFQM) in 2008.

The Faculty

Since 1998, the SLT programme (*Logopedia*) is taught in the Faculty in Talavera (Toledo), adapted to Bolonia Process in 2008. It is one of the fourteen SLT programmes in Spain. The curriculum is based in 240 ECTS in total to obtain the 4 years Degree.

Pre-requisites to study the Programme

Applicants have to perform a national access exam (PAU). The ratio is 60 new students per course.

Content of Studies

The studies include theoretical studies, organised in different modules, such as: logopedics, biological sciences, psychology, linguistics, education, lifespan development, law and medicine, so as to clinical problem solving, clinical skills, school and clinical placements (the 3rd and 4th year), as well as studies in research methods. Each module allows the acquisition of knowledge, skills and attitudes, in both, theoretical and practical level, through different educational methods: lectures, practical classes, seminars, independent work, group work, practices, placements, etc.

Students complete their Degree only by presenting an original work (intervention or research based) corresponding to the T.F.G. (*Trabajo de Fin de Grado*) associated to different lines.
