The **Faculty of Health, Psychology and Social Care** offers a wide portfolio of courses. These include nursing, physiotherapy, psychology, social work and speech and language therapy (SLT).

There are 2 courses leading to a qualification in SLT. These are:

**BSc Hons Speech Pathology and Therapy:** a 3.5 year course with an intake of 36 each year

**BSc Honours in Psychology and Speech Pathology:** a unique, joint honours 4 year course with an intake of 14

### Prerequisites (for both courses)

**Standard entry** (*typically school leaver*)

BBB at Advanced level or equivalent plus specified 5 GCSEs, plus questionnaire

**Non-standard entry** (*normally out of full time education for at least 3 years*)

Evidence of successful academic study to A level standard or above within the last 5 years plus specified GCSEs/O levels plus questionnaire

### Course content

**All students:** biological sciences, clinical problem solving, clinical skills, lifespan development, phonetics and linguistics, psychology, research methods, research project, school and clinical placements, speech pathology.

**Joint Honours students:** additional courses across the discipline of psychology
