

## THE SPEECH AND LANGUAGE THERAPY STUDY PROGRAMME

### **University of Ljubljana**

Faculty of Education

The University of Ljubljana was founded in 1919. It has 3 arts academies and 23 faculties. The University is based in Ljubljana, it is the capital of Slovenia.

The Speech and Language Therapy Study Programme is the only SLT programme in Slovenia and is situated in the Faculty of Education, at the Department of Special Education and Rehabilitation. The yearly intake into the SLT programme is about 20-25 students.

The prerequisites for entry into the programme:

General conditions for enrolment into the programme state that anyone who has passed the matura exam or has, prior to 01.06.95, completed any four-year secondary school programme.

Special conditions state the criteria for selection in the case of limited enrolment (general success in the matriculation or concluding exam - 60% of the points and general success in the 3rd and 4th years - 40% of the points).

Course description:

The SLT programme is a full-time study programme, duration of 8 semesters, leading to a Master of Science (one year) in Speech and Language Therapy. The course includes a theoretical and a clinical/educational practical component. The theoretical component includes courses in biomedical subjects, behavioural studies, linguistics, speech and language pathology and communication therapy, as well as other subjects such as research methodology.

Other information:

There is also one specific area included in the programme that is pedagogy for the deaf and hard of hearing persons.
