

CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY COLLEGE BRUGES-OSTEND (KHBO)

Presentation of the university college.

Catholic University College Bruges-Ostend (B) provides a whole range of professionally and academically oriented study programmes at the level of Bachelor and Master.

It has 4 faculties:

Faculty of Engineering Technology

Faculty of Education and Teacher Training

Faculty of Health Care

Faculty of Management and Business Studies

Prerequisites to be able to study in the programme.

A secondary education certificate is necessary.

Direct access is also given to holders of a foreign qualification recognized on the basis of a Flemish degree, a Belgian law, a European Directive or an international convention.

Admission may also be granted to students after individual assessment of their secondary education certificate and to persons who are unable to meet the general admission requirements.

Content of the studies and the degree.

The Bachelor in Speech and Language Therapy or Audiology is a 3 year professional Bachelor Programme (180 ECTS) that leads to a Professional Bachelor Degree in Speech and Language Therapy or Professional Bachelor Degree in Audiology.

The Bachelor of Speech Therapy and Audiology starts with a common two-year core programme (2 x 60 ECTS credits).

In the third year (60 ECTS credits) the final choice has to be made between a final specialisation in Speech Therapy or in Audiology.

Once the Bachelor degree has been obtained with a given final specialisation, an additional 60 ECTS credits programme can be taken in order to also obtain the Bachelor degree in the other specialization.

Other information.

KHBO is associated with the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven and with 11 other Flemish university colleges which makes together 44% of the Flemish student population in higher education
