



### **Presentation of the University and the faculty:**

The institutes of Health Studies, Nursing, Sport and Social Studies of the HAN's Faculty of Health and Social Studies in Nijmegen offer a broad variety of Bachelors, Exchange and Masters Programmes.

### **Prerequisites to be able to study in the programme and the yearly intake:**

The Netherlands has a binary system of higher education with two types of programmes (diploma's of secondary school 'HAVO' or 'VWO' or completion of professional secondary programmes at level 4 'MBO') that grant admission to a university of applied sciences.

### **Yearly intake:**

Our SLT course starts in september and our yearly intake is about 200 students. About 50% of our students come from Germany. Therefore the lectures are given in both Dutch and German.

A screening of the candidate's own speech and voice is part of the requirements.

### **The content of the studies and the degree:**

The curriculum consists of a four-year programme concluded with examinations associated with a certificate. A variety of examining methods are periodically used to evaluate theoretical knowledge, practical skills and professional attitudes.

Students are awarded a Bachelor of Health Care in Speech and Language Therapy.

Upon successful completion of the BA course, it is possible to enroll in a Master's programme.

We also have a special programme in cooperation with the Radboud University Nijmegen. Our students can follow a five-year routing towards a bachelor and a masterdegree SLP (Speech and Language Pathology).
