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9. Abstract of publication or Summary of activity (in English) **150 words:**

Speech and language therapy (SLT) education in Europe has many differing forms, languages and levels. Also, the European Union has developed methods of comparing educational provision, highlighted in the Bologna declaration (EHEA, 1999) and in the European Higher Education Area (EHEA). These actions made a starting point for a project to allow easier comparisons and understanding of similarities and differences in academic programmes, and of the qualified SLT professionals' profiles. The project is called Network for Tuning Standards and Quality of Education Programmes in Speech and Language Therapy/Logopaedics across Europe (NetQues). The main outcome of the NetQues project was the identification of benchmarks for SLT education and for the clinical competencies of newly qualified SLTs which should be applied across the EU.
