## 9. Abstract of publication or Summary of activity (in English) 150 words:

In Slovenia, there is only one institution where the training/education for speech and language therapists takes its place and this is Faculty of Education, which is a part of University of Ljubljana. Our Faculty participated as a leading partner for Slovenia in the NetQues project. The main objective of the project was to establish common standards and criteria for the training of speech and language therapists, to define and develop skills which are essential for speech and language therapists. SLT education in Europe differ from country to country according to the political, educational and socio-economic circumstances in the country. Given the diversity in content, duration, rate of speech and terminology of study programs, it was necessary to create a survey based on competences. It was proved that this was a need for accurate description of the skills that are necessary if you want to be and work as a speech and language therapist.
